



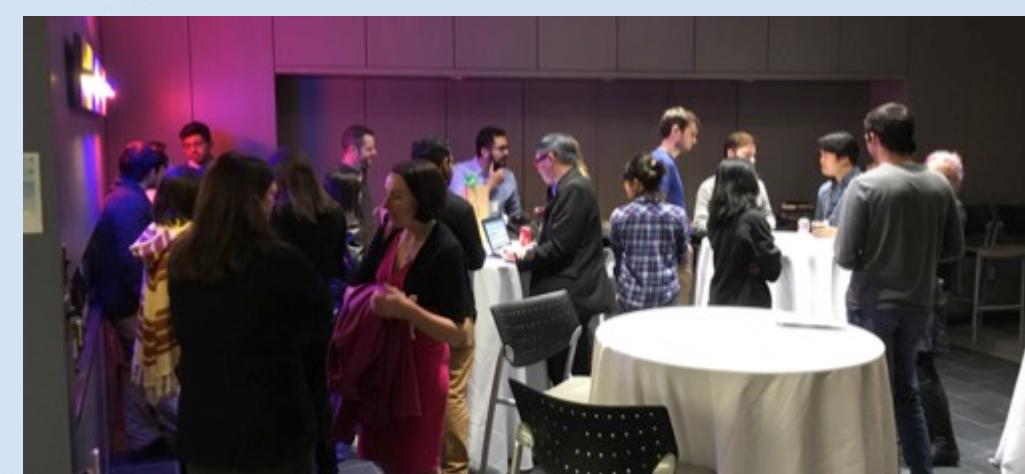
LANDRY CANCER BIOLOGY CONSORTIUM

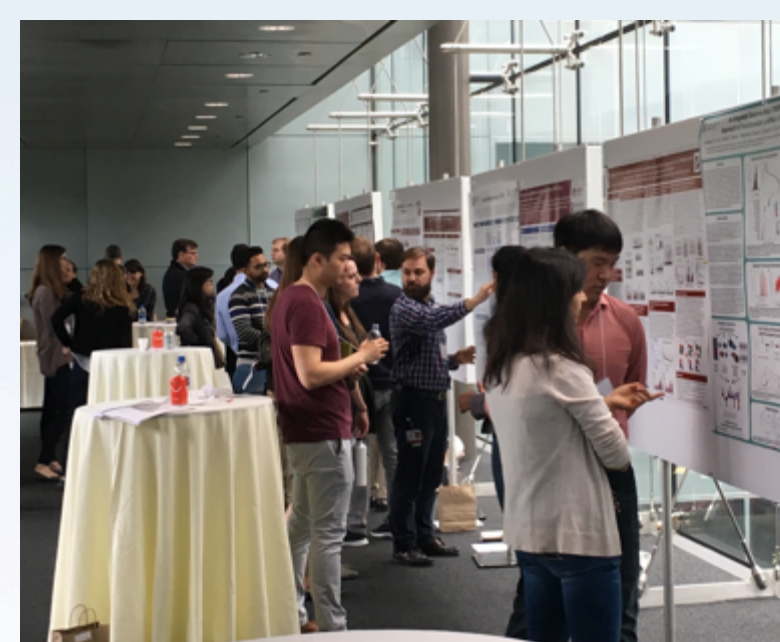
